Our Commitment to an Affordable Waldorf Education

Kimberton Waldorf School understands and honors the commitment of families to provide a Waldorf education for their children. For more than 80 years, we have partnered with families through our tuition assistance program to help make an independent Waldorf school education possible.

Tuition assistance is available for students in 4 or 5 full-day Rosebud Garden and Kindergarten and in grades 1 through 12. Families must reapply each year. New families are eligible to apply for tuition assistance as soon as they apply for admission to the school (application is available November 1 of the preceding academic year), however decisions will not be made until the student completes the process and is accepted. Students interested in enrolling after the start of the school year will be considered if funds remain. Late applications will be reviewed after the tuition assistance process for new families has been completed; any remaining funds will then be awarded to qualified late applicants.

Procedure

- Complete the online Parent Financial Statement (PFS) at <https://www.solutionsbysss.com/parents>, appropriate for your family's circumstances. You must upload your required documents as indicated in the online instructions. Self-employed individuals are required to complete the Family Farm and Business Form, which is also available online.
- Submit via email to the Tuition Assistance Committee at Kimberton Waldorf School, bookkeeper@kimberton.org, a written explanation of any special circumstances you want the Tuition Assistance Committee to be aware of.
